### What is the Malaysian Premium Visa Program (PVIP)?

1. "On September 1, 2022, the Malaysian government launched a 20-year residence visa called the 'Malaysian Premium Visa Program (PVIP)' to attract foreigners to 'invest and reside' in Malaysia."

### What are the benefits of the Malaysia Premium Visa Program (PVIP)?

1. Investors, entrepreneurs, and foreigners can obtain a 20-year residence visa by applying for the Premium Visa (issued in the form of 5+5+5+5 years). They can work, be employed, conduct business, invest, purchase property (residential or commercial buildings), and study in Malaysia.
2. There is no residency requirement.

### Is there an age limit?

1. *There is no age limit for applying for the Premium Visa. Anyone who meets the requirements can apply.*





Categories	PVIP	Remark
Main Applicant – Age Limit	No Limit	
Offshore Income	Required	A monthly salary of no less than RM 40,000 or an annual income of no less than RM 480,000 is required.
Deposit Requirement	Deposit RM 1,000,000.00	After one year, you can withdraw up to 50% of the deposit for property purchase, education, and healthcare.
Property Purchase Requirement	No	Not compulsory to purchase property; you can apply to withdraw up to 50% of the fixed deposit after one year for property purchase.
PVIP Validity	20 Years	Issued in the form of 5+5+5+5 ; renew every 5 years.
Residency Requirement	No	Free to enter and exit, with no restrictions on residency requirements.
Do Business / Work / Invest in Malaysia	Yes	Only the main applicant is allowed to work/invest/do business; dependents (spouse/family members) are not allowed.
Spouse / Dependents	Spouse ;Children / Step Children / Adopt Children (Age 21 Below); Disable Child (No Age Limit, Need Medical Prove); Parents and In-Laws	
Bring Foreign Helpers	Yes	Allowed to bring 1 foreign helpers.
Immigration Processing Fees	Main Applicant – RM 200,000 Dependent – RM 100,000	The main applicant needs to submit a 'nomination fee' of RM 20,000, with the balance to be paid after the approval letter is issued. <b>***Note: The nomination fee is “non-refundable” ***</b>
Agency Service Fees	Main Applicant - RM 80,000 Dependent – RM 45,000



After Confirming Package, **Sign Agency Agreement**, Pay The **"Nomination Fees" RM 20,000** \*\*\***Note: The Nomination Fees Is "Non-Refundable"\*\*\***, and **50% of the agency service fees for all applicant as a "reservation deposit"**

All applicants need to prepare the **necessary documents** and **document certifications**

4

All application documents will be submitted to the **Immigration** for **approval**.

5

Once the conditional approval letter for the Premium Visa Program (PVIP) is issued, the main applicant must pay the Immigration Department **processing fee of RM 180,000 within 7 days**, the **processing fee for each dependent at RM 100,000**, as well as the **remaining 50% of the agency service fee**.

6

All applicants must enter Malaysia for visa **stamping within 6 months** after the conditional approval letter is issued.

7

Applicants need to open a **fixed deposit account at any bank in Malaysia**, do **body check-up** and **buy medical insurance**
